•When we receive Christ's mercy, it's our responsibility to show mercy to others.

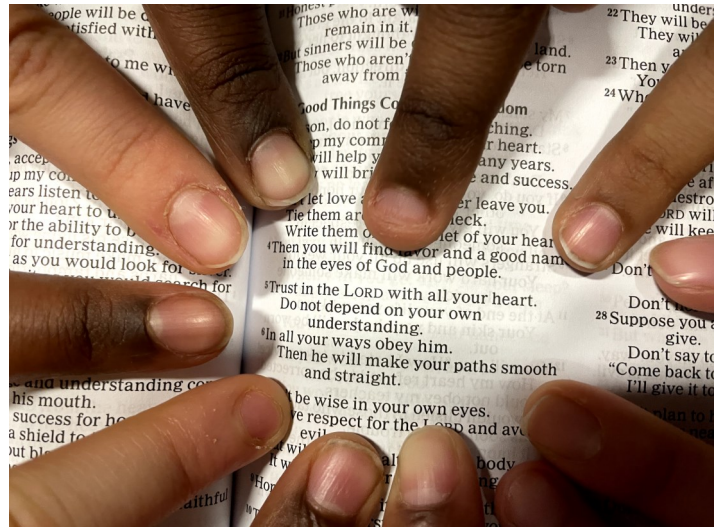

Mrs. Erica Petersen was born and raised in Cape Town, South Africa. She graduated with two degrees- a Bachelor of Education and Bachelor of Education Honours for Special Needs and Sciences.
